With reference to your memorandum of 20th November last to the Secretary of State, I beg to inform you that we are now in receipt of a letter from the Director of the Bureau of Navigation of the U.S. Shipping Board, dated 21st August, enclosing a copy of a circular letter addressed to the Consul General of the U.S.A. at Rio de Janeiro, dated 18th August, which states that the Consul General has been instructed to issue a circular letter to all American shipping agents in Brazil, requiring them to furnish to the Consul General a copy of their charter party agreements with Brazilian owners, so that the Consul General may be enabled to take such action as may be necessary to protect the interests of American shipowners in Brazil.
