stating freeboards which could be assigned in the case of the
Steamer "AKUNA", I am now informed by the Owners that they
are satisfied to have a freeboard of 8' 6" for all seasons,
corresponding to a moulded draught of 15' 0½", assigned to this

Arrangements have therefore been made to have non-
removable screwed plugs fitted at the inner ends of all overboard
drain pipes from the second deck, and a second automatic non-
return valve, accessible at all times, to all sanitary discharge
pipes from spaces on the second deck, at the first convenient
opportunity.

When this work has been carried out, the matter will
be fully reported.
