THE UNA SOLD

FOR MELBOURNE PILOT SERVICE

H.M.A.S. Una, formerly the German patrol boat Komet, has been purchased by Captain Rose on behalf of the Melbourne pilot service. She will be stationed at Port Phillip.

The vessel was captured during the war at New Guinea and brought to Sydney, being subsequently used for patrol work in the Mandated Territory. After she came to Sydney, and was laid up until formally declared a prize. The vessel was originally built for the North German Lloyd, and in her early days was commanded by Captain Muller, a relative of Captain Muller's fame. The Una is at present at Port's Dock undergoing an over-preparatory to leaving for Melbourne.
