This vessel was built in 1911 by the Bremen Vulcan and classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, and has now been purchased from the Government by the Port Phillip Sea Pilots.

The Sydney Surs . have forwarded a First Entry Report on the Machinery together with plans of the shafting and pumping arrangements and they state that a plan of the boiler and a report on the condition of the latter will be forwarded when completed.

The sizes of shafting as given on the First Entry report as such as could be approved for a working pressure of 130 lbs. per sq. inch, the pressure to which the safety valves on all main boilers have been adjusted, the pumping arrangements as shewn on the plan and detailed on the First Entry Report are also in order provided a 2½" Donkey pump direct suction to the Engine Room Bilges be fitted as recommended by the Sydney Surs.

It is submitted that action be deferred awaiting receipt of the Boiler plan, and 1st. Entry report on the condition of the Boiler .
