CERTIFICATE FOR THE CARRIAGE OF CARGO OIL IN BULK

This is to Certify that

K. Kishigami,

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' representative, survey the Deep Tank of the T.S.S. "AFRICA MARU", 9414 tons gross, of Osaka, whilst the vessel lay afloat at this port of Kobe.

The After Deep Tank was tested on the 18th. July 1931 by a head of water to the top of the air pipes 3 feet above weather deck, and upon examination, the boundary bulkheads, tank top, hatches, ventilators and other connections were found sound and tight.


The Double Bottom Tank in way of this Deep Tank was tested on the 1st. July 1931 by a head of oil fuel to the top of the sounding pipes on the weather deck and found sound and tight.

The Deep Tank is considered fit to receive a shipment of cargo oil in bulk subject to examination for cleanliness before loading.
