Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to non-perishable cargo only being carried in the lower refrigerated chambers until these are repaired.

The Nagasaki Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

Alterations with a view to oil fuel being carried for burning purposes have been effected to the Surveyors' satisfaction and the insulation in the lower refrigerated chambers completely renewed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 3,24, as recommended, without special condition.
