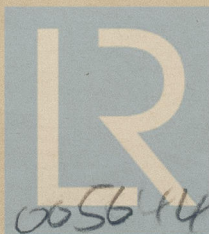
Dear Sir:

In discussing the matter with the Owner's representatives, it would seem that the recent recommendations of Rear-Admiral E.S. Land of the United States Maritime Commission regarding classification, influenced their decision which I tried to have reconsidered especially in respect to the S/S "HARRY COULBY", but they said that as this company carried their own insurance, classification was not of much importance to them, further that it simplified matters to have American Bureau class only.
