Cargo batteries not fitted. Lited for 0.2-10,20 HP above 150°F.

Survey Due 2nd Special Survey No. 2 due 6,41, partly held.
Boiler Survey due 9,41.

It is understood this vessel has been "acquired" by the Japanese and is now sailing as "MEISAN MARU".

The Norwegian Shipping and Trade Mission now state that they are no longer interested in the vessel and it is submitted that in the circumstances the case might be dealt with similarly to the Steamer "SHENG HWA" in which instructions were given for the class to be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book.
