Set of Standard A Type Engines was built by Messrs
Fairfield S.B. & Eng Co. to the order of the Controller of
Navy Shipping as a Spare Set.
Engines have been bought by Messrs Kincaid
for export to Messrs Coughlan of Vancouver.
The ^{GB} Surveyors have been informed by Messrs
Fairfield & Messrs Kincaid that neither of these
hold themselves responsible for the payment
of Survey fees.

The practice in the case of machinery
which has been completed to the order of the
Shipping Controller to charge the whole of
fees as per Circular 1307 to the builders
to recover the same from the Controller.

Messrs D & W Henderson's Standard A type engines
referred to in the Glasgow letter were
of four sets of engines supplied by
Messrs Kincaid to Messrs Coughlan to be
fitted in 4 vessels built to the order of the
Canadian Ministry of Marine, in which
a fee of £50 per set was agreed upon
between the Canadian Ministry and this Society,
paid by the Canadian Ministry
for other engines supplied by Messrs
Kincaid & fitted by Messrs Coughlan into
vessels for private owners were charged
the full Standard rate viz £58-10-0,
and these fees were paid by the
builders of the engines.
