Survey Due

This vessel was built for the Admiralty under Special Survey and was assigned the Class "~~100A~~", "Steam Trawler", "For Government Service" "1,44", "LMC 1,44".

In accordance with the usual practice particulars were entered in the "Ghost" Book but not in the ordinary Register Book.

Information has now come to hand that the vessel has been sold to Norwegian Owners and converted to a tank steamer at a Netherlands Ship Yard. She is now trading under the name of 'VESLEMOY'. The alterations were not carried out under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors and it is stated that the conversion took place under Norske Veritas survey.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED that the vessel's class should be withdrawn from the "Ghost" Book and her name inserted in the ordinary Register Book as a disclassed vessel.
