With reference to the Classing Letter sent to you on the 1st instant respecting the steamer "ALABAMA", recently completed by the Chantiers de Normandie, of Rouen, the machinery of which vessel was built under your survey by the Soc. des Ateliers & Chantiers de France, I have to inform you that the Nantes Surveyor has now forwarded a letter which he has received from the Owners of the vessel, from which it appears that the machinery certificate has not yet reached their hands.
