Reverting to our previous correspondence regarding the difference of this and other Society's requirements in respect of air compressors and pumping arrangements, I have to acquaint you that I have now received a communication from the Groningen Surveyor to the effect that in view of the Society's requirements as regards these items, the Owner has decided to class the motorship "HELENA" with the Bureau Veritas.
