With regard to any ships referred to in the letter, I may say that no request or visit has been received from them here, but this will receive your attention should it materialise.

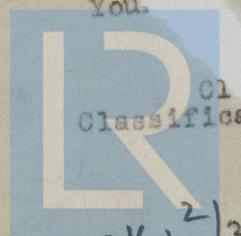
