I beg to inform you that the motorship "MITTELMEER", No.80764 in the Register Book, has recently arrived at Immingham from Germany under her own power and I am now informed that the Eagle Oil & Shipping Co.,Ltd., are taking this vessel over.

I have conferred on board with Mr. Kennedy, the Superintendent of the Eagle Oil & Shipping Co.,Ltd., who desires to know, as soon as possible, if the Committee will accept a General Examination in drydock, Modified Machinery Survey, Boiler Survey and Tail Shaft Survey to enable this vessel to become reclassified with this Society until such time as the Special Survey can be held. The Owners desire to carry out the Renewal Freeboard Survey and also propose to test all tanks in this vessel. The question of where this survey will be held has not yet been decided but it will probably be held at Immingham in the near future.

I shall be glad to have your instructions regarding this case.
