The survey shafts of each of these Brazilian vessels became due for survey in September 1912.

The vessels are engaged in trading out of the port of Bahia, where the Society has no Surveyor stationed. The Committee, however, have agreed to the necessary surveys being held by a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agent at Bahia.

The Owners have been communicated with from this Office without reply, and Lloyd's Agent states that he has made several inquiries on the subject, and has informed the owners that unless a reply is received the vessels will lose their classification.

Lloyd's Agent now writes that it has been impossible to obtain any replies, and on the cases coming before the Classing Committee on the 26th ultimo, it was decided to expunge the vessels' classes from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules:—(9,13)
