With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "PORTO-SEGURO", I beg to remind you that letters relative to the survey of the screw shafts, which became due on this vessel in September, 1912, were addressed to you from this Office on the 20th February and 24th May last, and that no reply has been received to these communications.
