Survey on the vessel "AMAGISAN MARU"

I, the undersigned registered marine surveyor, certify that at the request of Messrs Smith, Bell & Co., Ltd., Lloyd's Agents at Cebu, I surveyed the vessel "Amagisan Maru" on the 4th. inst., as she lay alongside the wharf at Cebu, in consequence of the coastwise steamer "Bisayas", whilst pulling away from the wharf, contacted the vessel "Amagisan Maru" on her port bow, opposite her No. 1 hatchway, at 10.00 P.M. of the 3rd. inst..

On examination of the vessel on the day named, I found no damage, other than the fore and aft scraping of the paint on fwd. port side of the "Amagisan Maru", for the length of her No. 1 hatch.

From the surveys that I have been able to make, as far as possible, I conscientiously believe the said vessel can proceed on her voyage, being in a seaworthy condition and fit to retain her present classification, and carry dry and perishable cargo and present liquid cargo.
