Dear Sirs,


I duly received your letter of the 14th instant from which I note that you desire the load draught of the above vessels to be increased to 26'-7" instead of 26'-4" as originally designed.

With regard thereto, I have to inform you that as the scantlings originally proposed by you were somewhat in excess of our minimum Rule requirements for a designed draught of 26'-4" the deeper loading now proposed is quite satisfactory without any modification to the scantlings as approved.
