

Dear Sirs,

With reference to the correspondence which has taken place between us in regard to the Electric Light Installation of your steamer "NORTHQUAY", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Bristol report that they have examined the installation as far as possible in its completed condition and that their recommendations have been carried out, with the exception of the fitting of an automatic indicator in connection with the navigation lights.

I am directed, however, to say that the Committee cannot agree to the fitting of this indicator being dispensed with and that the requirements of Section 7, paragraph 'b', of the Rules for Electric Fittings on Board Ships must be complied with.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly arrange for this to be done and advise the Society's Surveyors in due course.



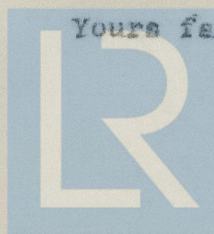
