We had a call today from Mr. Longo, Superintendent of Messrs Lloyd Triestino S.N.C., who stated it is desired that the above steamer should undertake a voyage from Trieste to Bombay, leaving this port on 15th inst., for which purpose a Consular Certificate is required before the vessel sails. The said gentleman stated and the Registro Italiano confirmed that the bottom, rudder, sea connections and tailshaft of the vessel were examined in drydock in March last by the Surveyors of the Registro Italiano who found same in order with the exception of some slightly indented shell plates, which were recommended to be dealt with at Owners' convenience. The Owners propose to have the engines and boilers now opened up for examination and the hull surveyed afloat, with a view to a Consular Certificate being issued from this Office.

We are informed that the vessel has no freeboard certificate from the Registro Italiano.

We confirm our today's telegram as per enclosed translation.
