With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo enclosing First Entry Reports in the cases of the "MATCHLOCK" and "FLINTLOCK", I have to draw your attention to the fact that in accordance with the terms of my letter of the 22nd October, 1945 (copy enclosed) all classification and supervision fees are the Shipbuilders liability. The letter from the Director of Navy Contracts therein referred to was dated the 19th October, 1945, under reference C.P.Br.8B/79013/45/V431.

I have therefore to request that you will be good enough to render an account in respect of the supervision of the requirements of the specification accordingly, in each case.
