Messrs. J. Dickinson & Sons, Ltd., attend at their Works in Sunderland, on 26th November, 1942, and subsequently for the purpose of examining one compound engine during construction (A/MS No. 573. Brown Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Co. Ltd. No.11.)

The parts examined appear to be sound and free from defect.

The high pressure cylinder and low pressure cylinder were hydraulically tested 180 lbs. per sq. inch and 30 lbs. per sq. inch respectively, also main condenser tested to 20lbs. per sq. inch.

All the requirements of the Admiralty Specification have been carried out in respect of engines, shafting and stern tube.

The cylinders and condenser have been stamped for identification as follows:-
