S. With reference to Glasgow First Entry Reports Nos. 33675 on the steamer "BADORA", I have to acquaint you that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyor at Calcutta, from which it appears that the vessel has now been re-constructed, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the vessel has been classed A1 "Coasting", Barisal and Chittagong, with notations of Lloyd's A&CP and LMC 10,14.
