Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow on the new steamer "BADORA", from which it appears that this vessel has been shipped in pieces to your port, where she will be re-erected.

I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention and forward a report on Form 8 to this Office on completion of the work with a view to the classification of the vessel.

You should, however, before commencing the survey for the re-erection and completion of the vessel, ascertain whether the Owners desire to have the vessel completed under your survey with a view to the assignment of a class in the Register Book, and if they are willing to pay the fee for this survey.

In the event of the survey for classification being proceeded with, you should furnish the necessary particulars for freeboard assignment on the new report form 11a as early as possible, and for your guidance in dealing with this matter I have to refer you to the case of the sister vessel "SITAKHOOND".

I enclose for your information and guidance a copy of the first entry report of the vessel, and also sketches of midship section and profile. It will be observed from the plans that two further vessels are under construction, and you will therefore be at liberty to retain the plans for reference in dealing with these cases, and you should return the plans to this Office when the report on the last vessel is completed.
