Dear Sir,

I have noted the contents of your letter dated 26th instant relative to the case of the steamer "CUDERKERK" and I have to enclose herewith the letter received from the Director of the Company, Mr. Koning as desired.

Where you refer to the survey held at Hamburg, and that nothing as to class was mentioned, I may state that there was no reason for doing this, but as soon as the vessel arrived back in Holland a Dutch certificate for freeboard had to be issued by the freeboard Commission and as the vessel was sailing with the G.L. freeboard marking and certificate, the Owners had to decide between that placed on the vessel's side, or the marking given by the Society and as you will notice from their letter they decided to keep the G.L. class.
