With reference to Mr. Leeuwenburg's letter of the 18th instant relative to the case of the Steamer "OUDERKERK", I have to acquaint you that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg of an examination made of this vessel afloat and in drydock.

The vessel was recommended for a fresh record of survey subject to the chain cables being ranged and the new cables and anchors being examined and compared with the certificates of test.

No remark was made that the vessel's class should be withdrawn, and in view of the last paragraph of your letter above referred to, I have to request that you will be good enough to forward the letter received from Mr. Koning, in which it was stated that the vessel's class should be withdrawn from this Society's Register Book.

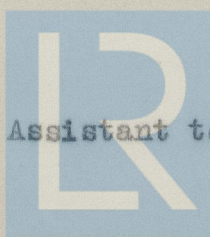
