Nature of Survey

Scantling Nos. .. 96 & 45696.

Proportions:- Length = 13.4 depths to upper deck,
11.0 depths to Bridge deck.

This vessel was built at Vegesack in 1915 and classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

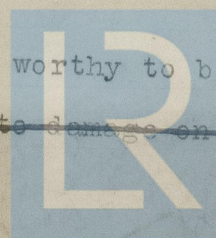
A plan and anchor and chain cable certificates were examined in June last and the vessel approved for the class 100 A1, with freeboard, subject to the Surveyors satisfying themselves regarding the construction of various parts and to the equipment of stream chain or wires, towline and hawsers and warps being found or made equal to the requirements of Table 31.

Reports have now been received from the Hull and Rotterdam Surveyors giving particulars of scantlings etc. and these appear to be generally in accordance with the approved plan.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock, the requirements of Section 48 of the rules complied with, and a S.S.No.3 carried out, and repairs effected on account of damage.

The equipment of stream wire, towline and hawsers and warps is as required, and the Surveyors have satisfied themselves regarding the construction of various parts.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A.1. (Steel), with freeboard, ~~subject to damage on starboard~~


