Dear Sirs,

With reference to your First Entry Report No.32693 on the Steel S.S. "ORSINO", ex "GERA", I have to inform you that before this case receives consideration it will be necessary for you to furnish information respecting the following points:-

1. Whether the frame spacing forward of the 3/5ths length, and in the peaks and second deck beams are as approved or as stated in your report.
2. Whether the 3rd Deck in No.1 hold is as approved.
3. Whether the plating is way of sidelights has been examined.
4. Whether ceiling has been lifted as required.
5. Whether you have satisfied yourselves regarding the panting arrangements, strengthening of bottom forward, and construction of bulkheads and tunnel.
6. Whether arrangements are provided for draining the space above the fore peak tank.
7. Whether the recommendations in the ~~Mar~~ Report (Rpt.14) forwarded with your First Entry Report have been complied with.
8. Whether Section 48 of the Rules has been complied with.
9. Whether the record of "Cem" or "Asp" should be made in this case in the Register Book.

I shall also be glad if you will kindly forward particulars of the lengths and capacities of the water ballast tanks, if a plan of the tanks was available on board the vessel.
