Dear Sirs,

With reference to the case of the ex-German Steamer "GERA" now named "ORSINO", which is at present under survey at your port, I have to acquaint you that First Entry Reports have come to hand from the Society's Hull Surveyors, in which they state that to complete the survey for classification, the following remains to be done, viz:-

Damage on starboard side forward in way of break of forecastle to be dealt with as necessary; as regards the machinery, the crank shaft requires to be lifted and the main bearings re-metalled; the safety valves adjusted under steam and tested for accumulation, and the machinery to be tried under steam.

It is not certain from the reports, however, whether certain requirements of the Special Survey have been complied with, and I am placing myself in communication with the Hull Surveyors in the matter, and will write to you again upon the receipt of their reply.

I should add that an inclusive fee for the classification survey will be charged from this Office on receipt of your report in completion of the survey.
