Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "KORIAK", I beg to remind you that a notice in regard to the Boiler Survey, which became due at the end of November last, was sent to you from this Office on the 9th January, to which no reply has been received, and that a further communication addressed to you on the 9th April has also failed to elicit a reply.

In the circumstances the Committee, who had the case before them at their Meeting today, desire me to point out that the survey in question is now long overdue, and to say that unless definite arrangements are made for it to be held forthwith they will have no alternative but to deal with the vessel's class.

I shall therefore be glad to learn by return mail for the Committee's information what steps you propose taking in the matter.
