Sir,

Referring to the foot-note in the freeboard assignment letter of the 9th October of the T.S.M.V. "ASUKA MARU", Messrs. D. & W. Henderson & Co.'s No.658 M. vessel, I beg to state that the vessel has open rails fore and aft except for a length of about 75 feet abreast of the saloon house amidships and for about 30 feet abaft the forecastle. The area of the amidships bulwark is about 290 square feet and of the bulwark above the forecastle about 120 feet each side. There are two wash ports in amidships bulwark, each 27" x 18".
