This vessel stranded off the Latvian coast in February 1939. She was subsequently brought into Liepaja, where she was placed in drydock and temporary repairs were effected to enable her to be towed to the United Kingdom or Continent for further examination and repairs.

In reply to enquiry the United Baltic Corporation, Ltd., the Managers, now state that so far as they know the vessel is still at Liepaja and that her British Registry has been closed, seeing that she was declared a Constructive Total Loss on the 2nd May last.

Under normal conditions the casualty record assigned would have been "In port damaged - with date", but as the present conditions of censorship preclude such assignment the Classing Committee, who had this case before them on Tuesday, the 3rd instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be deleted from the Register Book.
