A report on Form Rpt.8 was posted the 15th ult., stating that temporary bottom repairs have been carried out subsequent to stranding, and that the vessel is fit in her present condition to be towed ~~for~~ to any place in U.K. or Cont. for carrying out permanent repairs to bottom, side plating, deck and superstructure and Machinery.

The Freeboard Renewal Survey will be carried out concurrently with reconditioning of the vessel. Meantime she is laid up at Liepaja.
