Dear Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 11th inst. regarding the verification of markings for the above mentioned vessel. The computation was made out in the New York Office of the American Bureau of Shipping - no information at the local office beyond the assignment.

Regarding the extent of the composition on the second deck, this extends from the after end of the No. 2 Hatch to the forward end of the No. 3 Hatch aft, taking in the midship part of the Vessel: this as original when Vessel was built.

The Summer freeboard is as stated and the Summer in tropical seas should be 11" as stated in your letter. The Fresh Water and Tropical Summer marks above the top of their respective lines are 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for Fresh and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for Tropical Summer.

The "CITY OF PANAMA", a sister ship to the above mentioned Vessel has the identical assignment - verification of same herewith enclosed.
