Dear Sirs,

With reference to your Freeboard Report No.5801 on the S.S. "CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO", Messrs. A.B.Gotaverken's No.376, I shall be glad if you will state the thickness and material of the covering on the main deck in way of the statutory deck mark amidships. It appears from the approved plans in this Office that a composition of some nature $2\frac{1}{2}$ " thick is fitted.

It is presumed that there is no camber on the main deck, that the non-return valves fitted to the overboard scuppers from the main deck are fitted in substantial metal castings other than cast iron, and that the channels for the weather boards at the openings in bulkhead at tonnage well are riveted to the bulkhead, but I shall be glad to receive confirmation of these points.
