
With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steam Trawler "CIMARRON",

I beg to acquaint you that the Special Survey No.3 prescribed by the Society's Rules became due at the end of April 1923 and has not yet been held.

Action as regards the vessel's classification has been deferred by the Committee, as it was understood the Special Survey would be carried out at Cadiz during April or May, but in a letter now received from the Society's Surveyors at that port it is stated that they are informed that you do not propose to carry out the necessary survey.

In all the circumstances, the Committee regret that they have now no alternative but to give instructions for the class to be expunged with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have at the same time to add that the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character in the Society's Register Book upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the
