
With reference to your letters of the 13th October and 27th November last year respecting the classification in this Society's Register Book of your Steamer "CAP CANTIN", I beg to acquaint you that the case has received the further consideration of the Committee, and in view of the fact that the Special Survey No. 2, which is now long overdue, has not yet been held, the Committee regret that they are unable to allow the vessel to retain her class any longer, and have accordingly given instructions for the character to be expunged with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory Report from the Society's Surveyors on completion of the necessary survey and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee, with a view to the reinstatement of the class.
