Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 14th ultimo respecting the classification of your steam trawler "ECCLESHILL", I beg to acquaint you that the case of this vessel received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, and that in view of no reply having been received to the several communications addressed to you, and of no definite arrangements having been made for the submission of the vessel to the Special Survey No. 2, which is now long overdue, the Committee regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I may add that upon the receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that all requisite surveys and repairs have been satisfactorily carried out, the vessel will be eligible to be submitted to the Committee with a view to the reinstatement of her character.
