Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steam trawler "ECCLESHILL" I beg to remind you that letters in regard to the Special Survey No.2 and Boiler Survey, which became due at the end of December and April last respectively, were addressed to you from this Office on the 20th September and 1st ultimo to which no reply has been received. The Society's Surveyors at West Hartlepool also state they have written to you in regard to the above surveys but have received no answer to their communication.

In the Circumstances the Committee, who had the case before them at their meeting to-day, direct me to say they consider definite arrangements should be made for the above surveys to be carried out in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class, and I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know for the Committee's information what steps you propose taking in the matter.
