The Second Special Survey No.2 became due in
July 1922.

This vessel has been lying up in the Genoa
district since August 1922, and at that time the Owner
was asked to furnish the usual undertaking.

The vessel came under inspection, however, and
arrangements were made to prepare her for the necessary
survey. The vessel left the port, and after considerable
discussion with the Owner's Superintendent it was understood
that the Owner would carry out the inspection at Leghorn
within a few days.

From a telegram and letter received from the
Leghorn Surveyor, it would appear that the vessel has not
been submitted to survey there, and in the circumstances
the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on
Tuesday, 4th instant, decided to expunge the class with
a red line (3.24), indicating non-compliance with the Rules,
and the Owner has been informed accordingly.
