Dear Sir,

S. With reference to your letter of the 8th ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Cadiz, respecting the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steam trawler "TIBURON", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them a communication received from the same Surveyors, from which it appears that you are unable to lay the vessel up for the examination of the screw shaft for some months, and that it is your desire that the class shall be withdrawn.

In the circumstances the Committee have decided to expunge the class from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

At the same time the Committee note that when the vessel is dry docked you will reconsider the question of classification, and I have to say that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary surveys and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee with a view to the re-instatement of the class.
