I duly received your letter of the 12th instant respecting the survey now long overdue on the screwshaft of the steam trawler "TIBURON" ex "NELLIE CRAWFORD" and I may say that the Committee have had this case before them at their Meeting to-day.

The remarks contained in your letter have been carefully noted and I have<sup>to</sup> say that in the special circumstances action in the matter has been deferred upon the understanding that the shaft will be drawn for the requisite inspection not later than October next. I shall be glad if you will notify the Owner accordingly.

I may perhaps point out that the vessel will become due for Special Survey No.1 at the end of the present month, and it would be as well to draw the Owner's attention to this fact.
