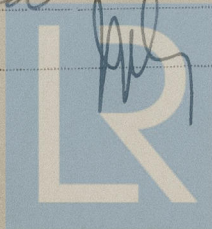
The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 23rd ultimo, and in the circumstances they deferred action for one month.
