Dear Sir,

I have now been able to glean some information with regard to the subject of trawlers as mentioned in your letter of the 28th August, which has not been possible before in view that the Owners and Directors have been away on holidays.

With regard to the "MARIA LUIZA 11", it has been promised that the deferred S.S.No.3 Survey will be carried out in January or February next; "AZEVEDO GOMES" is at present laid up at the moment in dry dock and has undergone a very thorough overhauling and Certificates and reports ~~will~~ will be made out on completion of survey; "OITO DE SETEMBRO" is similarly being overhauled and surveyed. With regard to the "RIO VOUGA", "RIO MINHA", "RIO ZEZERE" & "RIO TEJO", the Owners state that they cannot tell me anything definite yet as they are trying to sell them and cannot give any answer at present with regard to reclassification. I have further discovered that the "RIO LIMA" and the "RIO MONDEGO" have been sold, the latter to Arthur Cilia, Esq., and the former to him on account of the Company that own the "MARIA LUIZA 11", and I am following this up for corrected information. With regard to the "RIO GUARDIANA" and the "Rio DOURO", these have also been sold and I am endeavouring to trace the new Owners. Regarding the "CABO VERDE" this vessel was lost whilst on His Majesty's Service and as notified in my letter of the 19th July.
