Sir: ANSD 1/6 Trawler "RIO TEJO"

This vessel being laid up at present, Owners have requested a firm here to cut the water tight bulkhead fitted forward of fish room, to make an opening 1m25 high by 1m wide near the bottom & refuse to have a water tight door fitted in case of accident etc. so I shall be pleased to receive your special instructions regarding same as the place between the water tight bulkhead to be cut & the collision bulkhead is considerable; it would hold approximately 50 tons of water & if both compartments get filled i.e. fish room which carries 110 tons of fish & space forward of same, the vessel would very likely go under & I have told the Owners, who persist in having this done, that the Committee would very likely demand the vessel to be withdrawn from class, if such is persisted in.
