The *Hull* Surveyors report that they have examined the vessel in dry dock & found one plate & one frame on the starboard side set up & the Owner proposes to effect repairs at the next dry docking. The damage is stated to have been caused in launching the vessel.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed *+ 100A1 (Hull) Steam Trawler* as recommended subject to one plate & one frame being joined at the next dry docking as proposed.
