
In reply thereto beg to state that there are two sets of duplex pumps installed and connected for oil lubrication ready for immediate use and in addition there is one oil end piston and rod for lubricating pumps supplied.

Turbine thrust adjusting bushes are supplied but there are no liners for adjusting blocks in the list supplied by the makers.

We beg to refer you to our letter of the 19th inst. respecting the thickness of the second deck stringer angle which no doubt has reached you by this time.
