the General Electric Co. of Erie, Pa. attend at their works to survey during construction, a set of 3000 H.P. Gurtis Marine Geared Turbines made to the order of the Skinner & Eddy Corporation for a vessel building by them at Seattle, Wash.

The turbine and gears were assembled in the shop and tested under steam and found in good working condition.

I have recommended that the vessel in which the Machinery is fitted will be eligible for the record of * LMC (with date) when satisfactorily installed and tested under working conditions and spare gear being shipped as required by the rules.

For identification purposes the turbine and gears have been marked thus;- Turbine and shaft No. 140151 JR, Gear Casings, Gears, Pinions and Shafts No. 4401 JR.
