Replying to your letter of the 29th ultimo re the Steel Drifter "Era" I now beg to forward you as requested plan showing the alterations to Bulkheads which have been made at Peterhead. The Cross Bulkhead as shown in red on plan "B" is not watertight, the log of stiffeners and all rivets is not up to Rule requirements, the Stringers are cut at this bulkhead, and are not kneeed to same. The vessel was urgently required for Fishing, and the Owner, together with the Fisheries Board representative have promised to have repairs necessary to bring the vessel up to our satisfaction done, at the earliest possible date after the Yarmouth Fishing. Trusting further information is all you require.
