Sir,

I beg to draw your attention to the case of the Steel Drifter "Chimera", No. 54540 in the Register Book.

This vessel has undergone structural alterations at Peterhead, without our being informed of same. A Bulkhead has been fitted to form a Cross Bunker, and the Bunker ends as originally built in vessel removed. This Bulkhead is not watertight, the Side Stringers also were cut, and have not been kneed to bulkhead. It is requested that the Class be withheld until this Bulkhead is to our satisfaction, which the Owner proposes carrying out at Peterhead after the Yarmouth fishing.
